## **OVERVIEW**

Topic: Sanctification

Title: Freedom

Subtitle: How the Cross Kills Addiction

Description: Whether you are battling worry, loneliness, frustration, an addiction to pornography, or idols like money, we all seek deliverance from these addictions and idols into the freedom of the Gospel. ## **WEEK 1 (June 12)**

Title: A Beautiful God

## **WEEK 3 (June 26)**

Title: Adoption

## **WEEK 4 (July 10)**

Title: Affectionate Knowledge

Description: Enjoy learning how to read and discuss the Bible with your mind and your emotions.
